## AN ACT concerning

# Librarians - Employment in Institutions and Vocational Rehabilitation Programs

FOR the purpose of requiring that librarians in certain institutions be paid an annual salary that is not less than the annual salary received by public school teachers or librarians of similar training and experience in certain counties.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article - Education

6-303.

- (a) An individual employed as a teacher, LIBRARIAN, principal, director of education, or supervisor of vocational education on the staffs of the following institutions or in the following programs shall be paid an annual salary of not less than the salary received by a public school teacher OR <u>PUBLIC SCHOOL</u> LIBRARIAN of similar training and experience in the county where the institution is located:
  - (1) Boys' Village of Maryland;
  - (2) Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School;
  - (3) Montrose School;
  - (4) (3) Victor Cullen School;
- (5) (4) Any other institution that is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Human Resources or the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and
- (6) (5) Any vocational rehabilitation programs of the State Department of Education, the Division of Correction of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, or the Patuxent Institution.
