(House Bill 875)

AN ACT concerning

Health Insurance — Limitation or Denial of Benefits

~~FOR the purpose of prohibiting an insurer, including a nonprofit health service plan, from denying or limiting benefits for certain specified violations of the Maryland Vehicle Laws; and repealing a provision authorizing certain insurers to exclude coverage resulting from an insured who is intoxicated or under the influence of a narcotic.~~

Nonprofit Health Service Plans — Exclusions from Coverage

~~FOR the purpose of prohibiting a nonprofit health service plan from issuing, renewing, or delivering an individual or group contract that excludes coverage for hospital or medical expenses based on a certain violation of the Maryland Vehicle Law any provision of certain laws; and generally relating to exclusions from coverage by nonprofit health service plans.~~
