AN ACT concerning

**Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages License – University of Maryland at College Park ~~Education Conference Facility Dining Service~~**

**PG 315-90**

FOR the purpose of creating a special Class B beer, wine and liquor on-sale license for the Education Conference Facility Dining Service located at the campus of the University of Maryland at College Park in Prince George's County; providing for the scope and issuance of the Class B-ECF/DS license; establishing qualification for the license applicant; requiring the reporting of certain functions to the Board of License Commissioners within a certain time limit; providing for the deposit of the profits under this license; authorizing the Board of ~~License Commissioners~~ to regulate the manner of dispensing alcoholic beverages and designate the outlets under this license; designating the hours and days of sale under this license; requiring the Board to maintain certain information for license renewal purposes; exempting this license from certain regulations and prohibitions; limiting the number of licenses; and generally relating to the creation of a Class B-ECF/DS license in Prince George's County.
