suspend or revoke a license under certain circumstances; establishing certain hearing requirements and penalties; specifying that a county's or municipality's authority to regulate certain ambulance services is preempted by this Act; authorizing certain facilities to issue certain inspection certificates under this Act; specifying that if the Director elects to hire certain employees, the employee, employees shall without any change or loss of rights or status, retain their be transferred to the State merit system and shall be eligible to transfer to the State retirement system status or the State pension system; providing for the transfer of certain contributions and credits to the State system; specifying that the Director shall adopt certain regulations by a certain date; providing a certain delayed effective date for certain provisions of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the regulation of certain ambulance services.
