IN THE REPAYMENT OF THE AMOUNT OF ANY HIGHER EDUCATION LOAN; AND

- (3) TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SERVICE IN ECONOMICALLY AND ENVIRONMENTALLY DISADVANTAGED AREAS IN THE STATE.

  18–1903.
  - (A) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL:
- (I) ESTABLISH THE PRIORITY AREAS OF PUBLIC SERVICE ACTIVITIES ELIGIBLE FOR PUBLIC SERVICE PARTNERSHIPS;
- (II) ESTABLISH ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION; AND AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, AND COLLEGE CREDIT PROVIDED; AND
- (III) ADOPT ANY REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PUBLIC SERVICE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- (2) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL ENSURE THAT:
- (I) STUDENTS OR GRADUATES MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM THROUGH PERFORMANCE OF PAID OR VOLUNTEER EMPLOYMENT; AND
- (II) EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS UNDER THIS PROGRAM DOES NOT RESULT IN DISPLACEMENT OF EMPLOYED WORKERS OR IMPAIR EXISTING CONTRACTS FOR SERVICES.
- (B) (1) THERE IS AN ADVISORY BOARD TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM WITHIN THE COMMISSION.
- (2) THE ADVISORY BOARD IS COMPOSED OF THE FOLLOWING 5 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY:
- (I) 1 REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND INDEPENDENT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION;
- (II) 2 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNING BOARD;
- (HH) 1 REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM;
- (III) 1 REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION; AND
