

(IV) 2 MEMBERS WHO HAVE AN INTEREST IN PUBLIC SERVICE AND HIGHER EDUCATION.

(3) (I) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 2 YEARS.

(II) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(III) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(4) THE ADVISORY BOARD SHALL:

(I) REVIEW ALL PROPOSALS SUBMITTED BY INSTITUTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THIS PROGRAM;

(II) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS AS NECESSARY FOR IMPROVEMENT IN PROPOSALS; AND

(III) PREPARE AN ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE COMMISSION IDENTIFYING THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS PARTICIPATING AT EACH INSTITUTION.

18-1904.

(A) THE PRESIDENT, OR THE PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE, OF EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE SHALL ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE TO:

(1) IDENTIFY PUBLIC SERVICE NEEDS THAT CAN BE FILLED BY PARTICIPATING STUDENTS ~~AND GRADUATES; AND;~~

(2) DEVELOP A PUBLIC SERVICE PARTNERSHIP PROPOSAL; AND

(3) DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS FOR AWARDING COLLEGE CREDIT.

(B) THE PROPOSAL PREPARED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE ADVISORY BOARD FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL.

18-1905.

(A) STUDENTS ~~OR GRADUATES~~ OF ANY INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM BY PERFORMING PUBLIC SERVICE IDENTIFIED IN THE PROPOSAL.

(B) A STUDENT CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE SHALL RECEIVE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OR COLLEGE CREDIT ~~OR BOTH~~ IN EXCHANGE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM, AS PROVIDED IN ~~§18-1903(A)~~ §§ 18-1903(A) AND 18-1904(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
