

- (i) Cash;
- (ii) Certificates of deposit;
- (iii) Letters of credit from any bank or other savings institution; or
- (iv) Any other good and sufficient security; and

(2) Provide for their own liability insurance under subsection (a)(6) of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

(House Bill 986)

AN ACT concerning

Libraries – Records – ~~Prohibition of Oral~~ Inspection, Use, and Disclosure
