Unpaid hotel rental tax in Charles County, Somerset County, Talbot County, Washington County, [and] Wicomico County, AND WORCESTER COUNTY is a lien against the real and personal property of the person owing the tax and is collectible in the same manner as the property tax may be collected under the Tax – Property Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

(House Bill 1015)

AN ACT concerning

Unemployment Insurance - Benefits and Fund Contributions
