Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

645U.

(c) [The earnings of a prisoner, less payroll deductions required by law, shall be collected by, or surrendered to the Director of Probation for Harford County. From those earnings, the Director shall deduct: the amount determined to be the cost to the county of providing food, lodging and clothing for that prisoner; the actual and necessary food, travel and other expenses incidental to his participation in the program; the amount which the prisoner may be legally obligated to, or reasonably desirous of, paying for the support of his dependents; and credit any remaining balance to the prisoner’s account]

(1) A PRISONER WHO PARTICIPATES IN A WORK RELEASE PROGRAM AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL SURRENDER A REASONABLE FEE TO THE SHERIFF OF HARFORD COUNTY, DETERMINED BY THE SHERIFF TO BE THE COST OF PROVIDING FOOD, LODGING, AND CLOTHING FOR THAT PRISONER, AND OF THE ACTUAL AND NECESSARY FOOD, TRAVEL, AND OTHER EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE PRISONER’S PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM.

~~(2) FAILURE OF THE PRISONER TO SURRENDER THE FEE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS A VIOLATION OF THE CONDITIONS OF THE WORK RELEASE PROGRAM AND MAY SUBJECT THE PRISONER TO FURTHER COURT PROCEEDINGS AND ADDITIONAL PENALTIES.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

(House Bill 1054)

AN ACT concerning
