

exceeding 12 ounces in weight or size, for consumption off the premises, may be sold in a numerical quantity of less than six. IF BREWED BEVERAGES ARE SOLD IN A CONTAINERIZED PACKAGE, THE PACKAGE SHALL HOLD A MINIMUM OF 6 BOTTLES OR CONTAINERS. As to any Class B-1 or B-2 restaurant license issued on or after July 1, 1984, "off-sales" by Class B-1 and B-2 licensees are prohibited.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 645

(House Bill 1055)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages License Violation Proceedings

FOR the purpose of ~~removing Harford County from those counties that provide for a court procedure against a licensee or employee of a licensee who sells or furnishes alcoholic beverages to a person under a certain age or who is visibly intoxicated; making certain defenses unavailable in that County; including Harford County among those counties that allow for County law to prevail over the same prohibition; clarifying language; and generally relating to Harford County alcoholic beverages licensees and their employees and legal proceedings against them for certain unlawful sales or deliveries providing that certain bail bond prohibitions and a certain defense do not apply in certain criminal proceedings against an alcoholic beverage licensee or employee in Harford County; permitting in Harford County an alcoholic beverage law enforcement or licensing authority to proceed against an alcoholic beverage licensee when the licensee or the licensee's employee has been found not guilty or given probation before judgment in a criminal proceeding for certain alcoholic beverage violations; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to the enforcement of alcoholic beverage laws in Harford County.~~
