Annotated Code of Maryland (1987 Replacement Volume and 1989 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

9-204.2.

- (A) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 9-204 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT FOR A PERMIT TO INSTALL, MATERIALLY ALTER, OR MATERIALLY EXTEND A LANDFILL SYSTEM SHALL:
- (1) INCLUDE IN THE APPLICATION SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE REMOVAL OF ANY SOIL, REFUSE, OR OTHER MATERIAL FROM A VEHICLE BEFORE THE VEHICLE LEAVES THE SITE:
- (2) (1) PUBLISH NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION ONCE A WEEK FOR 2 CONSECUTIVE WEEKS IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE SITE OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT IS LOCATED; AND
- (3) (2) GIVE NOTICE OF THE APPLICATION BY CERTIFIED MAIL TO:
- (I) THE OWNERS OF ALL REAL PROPERTY ADJOINING THE SITE WHERE THE PROPOSED PROJECT IS LOCATED;
- (II) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODY AND ANY ELECTED EXECUTIVE OF THE COUNTY WHERE THE PROPOSED PROJECT SITE IS LOCATED;
- (III) THE ELECTED EXECUTIVE OF ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WHERE THE PROPOSED PROJECT SITE IS LOCATED; AND
- (IV) ANY OTHER COUNTY WITHIN 1 MILE OF WHERE THE PROPOSED PROJECT SITE IS LOCATED.
 - (B) THE PUBLIC NOTICE SHALL:
- (1) STATE THAT THERE IS AN APPLICATION FOR A LANDFILL SYSTEM PENDING BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT;
 - (2) GIVE THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE APPLICANT;
- (3) DESCRIBE THE LOCATION AND BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED SITE;
- (4) IDENTIFY WHERE THE APPLICATION AND ANY BACKGROUND AND SUPPORTING INFORMATION REGARDING THE APPLICATION IS AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION;
