- (D) (E) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE PROCEEDINGS, RECORDS, AND FILES OF THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE ARE NOT DISCOVERABLE AND ARE NOT ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE IN ANY CIVIL ACTION ARISING OUT OF MATTERS THAT ARE BEING OR HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND EVALUATED BY THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.
- (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY RECORD OR DOCUMENT THAT IS CONSIDERED BY THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE AND THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE SUBJECT TO DISCOVERY AND OR INTRODUCTION INTO EVIDENCE IN A CIVIL TRIAL ACTION.
- (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, CIVIL ACTION DOES NOT INCLUDE A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOARD OR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOARD.
- (E) (F) A PERSON WHO ACTS IN GOOD FAITH AND WITHIN THE SCOPE OF JURISDICTION OF AN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACTION AS A MEMBER OF THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE OR FOR GIVING INFORMATION TO, PARTICIPATING IN, OR CONTRIBUTING TO THE FUNCTION OF THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.

10-405.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "OPTOMETRIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE" MEANS A COMMITTEE THAT:
 - (1) IS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- (2) PERFORMS ANY OF THE FUNCTIONS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (C) (D) OF THIS SECTION.
- (B) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, AN OPTOMETRIST REHABILITATION COMMITTEE IS A COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OR A COMMITTEE OF THE MARYLAND OPTOMETRIC ASSOCIATION THAT:
 - (1) IS RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD; AND
- (2) IS COMPOSED OF <u>INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO</u> OPTOMETRISTS.
- (C) A REHABILITATION COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OR RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD MAY FUNCTION:
 - (1) SOLELY FOR THE BOARD; OR
- (2) JOINTLY WITH A REHABILITATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTING ANOTHER BOARD OR BOARDS.
