## REPRESENTING PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS THAT:

- (1) APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH:
- (1) IS RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD; AND
- INCLUDES BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS.
  - 1. THE BOARD; AND
- 2. ANY ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS; AND
  - (2) COMPOSED OF PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS.
- (C) A REHABILITATION COMMITTEE OF THE BOARD OR RECOGNIZED BY THE BOARD MAY FUNCTION:
  - (1) SOLELY FOR THE BOARD; OR
- (2) JOINTLY WITH A REHABILITATION COMMITTEE REPRESENTING ANOTHER BOARD OR BOARDS.
- (C) (D) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR REHABILITATION COMMITTEE EVALUATES AND PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO ANY PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR, AND ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL REGULATED BY THE BOARD, IN NEED OF TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION FOR ALCOHOLISM, DRUG ABUSE, CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY, OR OTHER PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL, OR MENTAL CONDITION.
- (D) (E) (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION, THE PROCEEDINGS, RECORDS, AND FILES OF THE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR REHABILITATION COMMITTEE ARE NOT DISCOVERABLE AND ARE NOT ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE IN ANY CIVIL ACTION ARISING OUT OF THE MATTERS THAT ARE BEING OR HAVE BEEN REVIEWED AND EVALUATED BY THE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.
- (2) PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO RECORD OR DOCUMENT THAT IS CONSIDERED BY PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR REHABILITATION COMMITTEE AND THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BESUBJECT TO DISCOVERY AND INTRODUCTION INTO EVIDENCE IN A CIVIL TRIAL ACTION.
- (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, CIVIL ACTION DOES NOT INCLUDE A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOARD OR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A PROCEEDING BEFORE THE BOARD.
- (E) (F) A PERSON WHO ACTS IN GOOD FAITH AND WITHIN THE SCOPE OF JURISDICTION OF A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR
