

amount which the prisoner may be legally obligated to pay for the support of his dependents by court order directed to the [warden] COMMISSIONER, which amount shall be paid to the dependents as the order directs; and the amount ordered to be paid by the court as restitution. Any balance remaining after these deductions and payments shall be credited to the prisoner's account and shall be paid to [him] THE PRISONER upon release. In those cases in which the prisoner's final earnings under a work release plan are required to satisfy the obligatory deductions set forth in this subsection, the balance of such earnings shall be forwarded to the prisoner within 15 days of the date of [his] release from the [jail] JAIL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 664

(House Bill 1213)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Gaming

FOR the purpose of prohibiting in Washington County certain individuals, corporations, and other entities from operating certain gaming devices on premises owned by, leased to, or used by certain individuals, corporations, or other entities that conduct bingo games for certain purposes; and generally relating to gaming in Washington County.
