VARIATIONS AMONG, AND CONTINGENCIES IN, FISHERIES, FISHERY RESOURCES, AND CATCHES; AND

- (V) SHALL AVOID DUPLICATION OF REGULATORY EFFORTS AND UNNECESSARY COSTS TO THE STATE AND TO ANY OTHER PERSON.
- (2) IF IT BECOMES NECESSARY TO ALLOCATE OR ASSIGN FISHING PRIVILEGES AMONG VARIOUS GROUPS OF INDIVIDUALS UNDER ITEM (1)(III) OF THIS SUBSECTION, OR UNDER ANY FISHERY MANAGEMENT PLAN, THAT ALLOCATION SHALL BE:
  - (I) FAIR AND EQUITABLE TO ALL INDIVIDUALS;
- (II) REASONABLY CALCULATED TO PROMOTE CONSERVATION; AND
- (III) CARRIED OUT IN SUCH A MANNER THAT NO PARTICULAR INDIVIDUAL, CORPORATION, OR OTHER ENTITY ACQUIRES AN EXCESSIVE SHARE OF SUCH PRIVILEGES.
- [(b)] (D) [The comprehensive] A FISHERY management plan [under this section] shall include:
- (1) [Sustainable] THE BEST AVAILABLE ESTIMATES OF SUSTAINABLE harvest rates; [and]
- (2) Indicators that would trigger any tightening or loosening of harvest restrictions[.];
  - (3) A DESCRIPTION OF THE FISHERY, INCLUDING:
- (I) THE HISTORY OF THE FISHERY, AND ITS CURRENT CONDITION RELATIVE TO HISTORIC POPULATIONS;
- (II) THE NUMBERS OF POTENTIAL COMMERCIAL AND RECREATIONAL FISHERMEN PROJECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FISHERY:
- (III) THE TYPE AND QUANTITY OF FISHING GEAR USED COMMERCIALLY;
- (IV) WHERE PRACTICABLE, THE COST LIKELY TO BE INCURRED IN THE MANAGEMENT OF THE FISHERY; AND
- (V) THE ACTUAL AND POTENTIAL REVENUES FROM THE RECREATIONAL AND COMMERCIAL FISHERY; AND
- (4) OTHER PERTINENT DATA THAT WILL ASSIST THE SECRETARY IN DETERMINING CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT MEASURES REASONABLY NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT THE FISHERY RESOURCES WILL BE SUSTAINED.
