(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "GROUP CONTRACT" MEANS ANY HEALTH INSURANCE CONTRACT OR POLICY THAT:

(I) IS ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE TO AN EMPLOYER BY AN INSURER OR NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN THAT PROVIDES HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS; AND

(II) COVERS A GROUP OF 100 OR FEWER INDIVIDUALS.

(3) "SUCCEEDING POLICY" MEANS A GROUP CONTRACT THAT:

(I) REPLACES OR SUCCEEDS A GROUP CONTRACT; AND

(II) IS EFFECTIVE WITHIN 65 DAYS OF THE DATE ON WHICH THE REPLACED OR SUCCEEDED GROUP CONTRACT TERMINATES.
