NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN THAT ISSUES A SUCCEEDING POLICY.

- (B) (1) A SUCCEEDING INSURER SHALL PROVIDE AN EMPLOYER WITH A WRITTEN STATEMENT PRIOR TO ENTERING INTO THE GROUP CONTRACT:
- (I) <u>SETTING FORTH A DESCRIPTION OF ANY WAITING</u>
 PERIODS FOR PREEXISTING CONDITIONS, EXCLUSIONS, OR SIMILAR
 POLICY PROVISIONS IN THE SUCCEEDING POLICY LIMITING OR
 EXCLUDING COVERAGE; AND
- (II) IDENTIFYING ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS COVERED UNDER THE GROUP CONTRACT REPLACED OR SUCCEEDED BY THE SUCCEEDING POLICY BUT WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FULL COVERAGE UNDER THE SUCCEEDING POLICY.
- (2) THE STATEMENT REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE SUFFICIENTLY CLEAR AND SPECIFIC SO THAT THE STATEMENT MAY BE UNDERSTOOD BY A PERSON OF AVERAGE INTELLIGENCE WITHOUT MAKING FURTHER INQUIRY TO THE SUCCEEDING INSURER.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, of the members initially appointed to the Maryland Small Business Group Health Insurance Board, 3 members shall serve 1 year terms, 3 members shall serve 2 year terms, and 4 members shall serve 3 year terms.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
