

(2) The automotive dismantler [or] AND recycler or scrap processor shall accept the certificate of authority instead of the certificate of title of the vehicle.

(3) THE AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER MAY APPLY FOR A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE AS PROVIDED IN § 13-507 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
