SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That notwithstanding § 13-920 of the Transportation Article, as amended by this Act, if a motor vehicle with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight of 7,000 pounds or more but less than 10,000 pounds meets all the other requirements for registration as a tow truck, the owner of the vehicle may:

(1) register the vehicle as a tow truck until July 1, 1991; and

(2) continue to renew the vehicle's registration as a tow truck until January 1, 2000, if after July 1, 1991:

(i) the vehicle is continuously registered as a tow truck; and

(ii) the owner of the vehicle does not transfer the vehicle to another owner.

~~SECTION 3.~~ AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

AN ACT concerning

Handicapped Students – Suspension and Expulsion

FOR the purpose of specifying certain conditions under which a handicapped student may be removed from a certain educational placement; specifying certain procedures for removal of certain students under certain conditions; specifying a certain presumption in certain proceedings; requiring continuing educational and related services in certain circumstances; generally relating to removal of handicapped students from their current educational placements; and making this Act an emergency measure.
