LOCATION FROM WHICH THE BUSINESS OF THE LICENSEE IS CONDUCTED.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That notwithstanding § 13-920 of the Transportation Article, as amended by this Act, if a motor vehicle with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight of 7,000 pounds or more but less than 10,000 pounds meets all the other requirements for registration as a tow truck, the owner of the vehicle may:

- (1) register the vehicle as a tow truck until July 1, 1991; and
- (2) continue to renew the vehicle's registration as a tow truck until January 1, 2000, if after July 1, 1991:
 - (i) the vehicle is continuously registered as a tow truck; and
- (ii) the owner of the vehicle does not transfer the vehicle to another owner.

SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 702

(House Bill 1498)

AN ACT concerning

Handicapped Students - Suspension and Expulsion

FOR the purpose of specifying certain conditions under which a handicapped student may be removed from a certain educational placement; specifying certain procedures for removal of certain students under certain conditions; specifying a certain presumption in certain proceedings; requiring continuing educational and related services in certain circumstances; generally relating to removal of handicapped students from their current educational placements; and making this Act an emergency measure.
