SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - State Finance and Procurement

7 - 310.

- (J) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SECTION AND SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER THE VEHICLE EXCISE TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM AND DISTRIBUTED TO THE ACCOUNT UNDER THE LAW AUTHORIZING THE VEHICLE EXCISE TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM MAY BE USED ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES FOR PROGRAMS OF THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE:
- (I) ADDED PLACEMENTS IN COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL SERVICES PROGRAMS;
- (II) ADDED SERVICES IN COMMUNITY-BASED VOCATIONAL AND DAY SERVICES PROGRAMS;
- (III) ADDED SERVICES IN FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAMS; AND
- (IV) ADDED SERVICES IN INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAMS.
- (2) FUNDS MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE ACCOUNT FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION ONLY BY:
  - (I) AN APPROPRIATION IN THE BUDGET BILL; OR
- (II) BUDGET AMENDMENT ONLY AFTER THE BUDGET AMENDMENT IS SUBMITTED TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
- SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

13 - 809.

(E) ANY PERSON WHO <del>VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION</del> FAILS TO PAY THE EXCISE TAX AS REQUIRED IN THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
