SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Tax - Property

SUBTITLE 4. PROPERTY OWNER'S BILL OF RIGHTS

1-401.

- IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT PROPERTY OWNERS IN THIS STATE HAVE:
- (1) KNOWLEDGE THAT THE VALUATION AND ASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION;
- (2) <u>UNDERSTANDING OF THE VALUATION AND ASSESSMENT</u> PROCESS;
- (3) ASSURANCE THAT THE VALUATION AND ASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY WITHIN CLASSES IS UNIFORM;
- (4) ACCESS TO INFORMATION WHICH IS THE BASIS FOR THE PROPERTY VALUATION AND ASSESSMENT PROCESS IN THIS STATE; AND
- (5) UNDERSTANDING THAT THE SETTING OF PROPERTY TAXE RATES AND THE COLLECTION OF PROPERTY TAXES IS A LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNCTION.

PROPERTY OWNERS IN THIS STATE HAVE THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:

- (1) THE RIGHT TO AN ASSESSMENT NOTICE UPON REASSESSMENT, AS PROVIDED IN § 8-401 OF THIS ARTICLE, THAT CLEARLY EXPLAINS:
- (I) THE PROPERTY OWNER'S RIGHT TO APPEAL AN ASSESSMENT;
- (II) THAT THE DETERMINATION OF VALUE IS BASED UPON INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE VALUATION RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT; AND
- (III) THE PROPERTY OWNER'S RIGHT OF ACCESS TO THE VALUATION RECORDS OF THE DEPARTMENT;
 - (2) THE RIGHT TO OBTAIN, AT NO CHARGE:
- (I) A BROCHURE EXPLAINING THE VALUATION AND ASSESSMENT PROCESS;
