**Judgeships – Circuit and District Courts**

FOR the purpose of altering the number of judges in the circuit courts and in the District Court of the State.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

Section 1-503 and 1-603(b)

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

1-503.

(a) In each county in the first seven judicial circuits there shall be the number of resident judges of the circuit court set forth below, including the judge or judges provided for by the Constitution:

(1) Allegany .....	2
(2) Anne Arundel .....	9
(3) Baltimore County .....	[14] 15
(4) Calvert .....	1
(5) Caroline .....	1
(6) Carroll .....	3
(7) Charles .....	3
(8) Cecil .....	2
(9) Dorchester .....	1

(11) Garrett .....	1
(12) Harford .....	4
(13) Howard .....	4
(14) Kent .....	1
