GOVERNMENT AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED) SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS PROVIDED IN §§ 1-401 AND 1-402 OF THIS TITLE, OR ANY OTHER LIMITATION RELATING TO THE AMOUNT OF RENTALS OR ELIGIBILITY OF TENANTS OTHER THAN AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND PROVIDED FURTHER, THAT A HOUSING AUTHORITY MAY MAKE PAYMENTS IN SUCH AMOUNTS AS IT FINDS NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE FOR ANY SERVICES, FACILITIES, WORKS, PRIVILEGES, OR IMPROVEMENTS FURNISHED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH ANY SUCH PROJECTS.

A HOUSING AUTHORITY MAY EXERCISE ANY OR ALL OF IT POWERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF COOPERATING WITH, OR ACTING AS AGENT FOR, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECTS BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF SAFE AND SANITARY DWELLINGS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL AND MAY UNDERTAKE THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF ANY SUCH PROJECT FOR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

ANY STATE PUBLIC BODY, AS DEFINED IN THIS ARTICLE, SHALL HAVE THE SAME RIGHTS AND POWERS TO COOPERATE WITH HOUSING AUTHORITIES WITH RESPECT TO THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECTS TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF SAFE AND SANITARY DWELLINGS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL THAT SUCH STATE PUBLIC BODY HAS PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF HOUSING PROJECTS FOR PERSONS OF ELIGIBLE INCOME.

BONDS OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS ISSUED BY A HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR A PROJECT DEVELOPED OR ADMINISTERED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE LEGAL INVESTMENTS TO THE SAME EXTENT AND FOR THE SAME PERSONS, INSTITUTIONS, ASSOCIATIONS, CORPORATIONS, BODIES, AND OFFICERS AS BONDS OR OTHER OBLIGATIONS ISSUED PURSUANT TO ANY OTHER SECTION OF THIS ARTICLE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A HOUSING PROJECT FOR PERSONS OF ELIGIBLE INCOME.

THIS SUBTITLE SHALL CONSTITUTE AN INDEPENDENT AUTHORIZATION FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY TO UNDERTAKE THE DEVELOPMENT OR ADMINISTRATION OF PROJECTS TO ASSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF SAFE AND SANITARY DWELLINGS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL AS PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE AND FOR A HOUSING
