## Maryland Racing Commission - Termination Date

FOR the purpose of extending the termination for certain provisions of law creating the Maryland Racing Commission, the Maryland Standardbred Race Fund advisory committee, and the Maryland-Bred Race Fund advisory committee.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 78B - Racing Commission

Section 26C

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1988 Replacement Volume and 1989 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 78B - Racing Commission

26C.

The provisions of this article creating the (1) Maryland Racing Commission, (2) Maryland Standardbred Race Fund advisory committee, and (3) the Maryland-Bred Race Fund advisory committee and relating to the regulation of horse racing and any regulations promulgated under this article are of no effect and may not be enforced after July 1, [1991] 2001.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 436.
