- (D) (E) BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, EACH APPOINTEE TO THE BOARD COMMISSION SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND CONSTITUTION.
 - (E) (F) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD COMMISSION ON JANUARY 1, 1991.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (5) A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE 3-YEAR TERMS.
- (F) (G) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.
- (A) (1) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD COMMISSION ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.
- (2) AT THE END OF A TERM, THE CHAIRMAN MAY BE REELECTED.
- (B) THE CHAIRMAN SHALL PERFORM THE DUTIES THAT THIS TITLE AND THE BOARD COMMISSION REQUIRE.
- (C) WHILE IN OFFICE, THE CHAIRMAN SHALL BE COVERED BY A SURETY BOND IN THE FORM AND AMOUNT REQUIRED BY LAW. 15.5–204.
- (A) A MAJORITY (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, 5 OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD COMMISSION IS ARE A QUORUM.
- (2) AT LEAST 2 OF THE 5 MEMBERS SHALL BE REAL ESTATE APPRAISER MEMBERS.
- (B) (1) THE BOARD COMMISSION SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH CALENDAR QUARTER, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD COMMISSION DETERMINES.
- (2) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD <u>COMMISSION</u> SHALL RECEIVE WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF A MEETING AT LEAST 10 DAYS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED DATE OF THE MEETING.
