- (A) THE BOARD SHALL RECEIVE ALL FEES AND OTHER MONEY COLLECTIBLE UNDER THIS TITLE.
- (B) THE AUTHORIZED EXPENSES OF THE BOARD SHALL BE PAYABLE ONLY OUT OF THE FEES AND OTHER MONEY THAT THE BOARD COLLECTS.

IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSION MAY:

- (1) SPONSOR RESEARCH AND OTHER EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES ABOUT REAL ESTATE APPRAISING; AND
- (2) ADOPT ANY REGULATION TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, THE COMMISSION SHALL PAY ALL MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

ANY PERSON AGGRIEVED BY A FINAL DECISION OF THE COMMISSION IN A CONTESTED CASE, AS DEFINED IN § 10-201 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, MAY TAKE AN APPEAL AS ALLOWED IN §§ 10-215 AND 10-216 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

THE BOARD COMMISSION EXERCISES ITS POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY.

ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE BY THE COMMISSION SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS REFORM, RECOVERY, AND ENFORCEMENT ACT OF 1989.

SUBTITLE 3. LICENSING

15.5-301.

(A) AFTER JUNE 30, 1991, AND EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD COMMISSION TO PROVIDE REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL SERVICES BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY PROVIDE REAL ESTATE APPRAISAL SERVICES IN THE STATE.
