(B) (1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A)(3) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) IN MAKING THE APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE STATE BOARD SHALL ENSURE THAT THE BOARD IS REPRESENTATIVE OF:

(I) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE; AND

(II) MINORITY PERSONS, AS DEFINED IN § 9-301 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(C) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON ~~OCTOBER 1, 1989~~ JULY 1, 1990.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.

(4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(D) THE STATE BOARD MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.

(E) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.

(F) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD IS A QUORUM.

(G) THE STAFF FOR THE BOARD SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE STATE BOARD.

(A) (1) (I) WITH THE ADVICE OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE AND SUBMIT THEM TO THE STATE BOARD ~~OF EDUCATION~~ FOR REVIEW.

(II) THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER FOR ADOPTION ANY PROPOSED REGULATIONS SUBMITTED UNDER THIS SECTION BY THE STATE BOARD.
