- (A) SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT MAY MAKE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE APPROPRIATE EDUCATIONAL AUTHORITY OF ANY OTHER STATE TO PROVIDE FOR RECIPROCITY IN THE CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS.
- (B) SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD, THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT MAY ACCEPT THE ACCREDITATION, FOR CERTIFICATION PURPOSES, OF A PROGRAM FOR TEACHER PREPARATION IF:
- (1) THE ACCREDITATION IS GRANTED BY A RECOGNIZED NATIONAL ACCREDITING AGENCY; AND
- (2) THE INSTITUTION PREPARING THE TEACHERS IS IN ANOTHER STATE.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- (A) (1) THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL APPOINT A REVIEW BOARD CONSISTING OF 5 MEMBERS.
 - (2) OF THE 5 REVIEW BOARD MEMBERS:
- (I) 1 SHALL BE THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS ACTING AS A LIAISON BETWEEN THE BOARD AND THE REVIEW BOARD;
 - (II) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
- (III) 2 SHALL BE PUBLIC SCHOOL CLASSROOM TEACHERS;
- (IV) 1 SHALL BE A CERTIFIED NONPUBLIC SCHOOL CLASSROOM TEACHER OR ADMINISTRATOR.
- (B) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER OF THE REVIEW BOARD IS 1 YEAR.
- (2) UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, A MEMBER OF THE REVIEW BOARD MAY BE REAPPOINTED ONCE.
- (3) THE TERM OF OFFICE SHALL BE FROM SEPTEMBER 1 OF THE CALENDAR YEAR IN WHICH THE APPOINTMENT IS MADE.
