AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicle Administration - Identification Cards - Nonresident Students

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue an identification card to an individual who is a nonresident student enrolled in certain schools and who presents a certain driver's license certain information to the Administration; requiring an applicant for an identification card under this Act to present an application on a form furnished by the Administration; and generally relating to the issuance of identification cards by the Administration to nonresidents.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

12-301.

- (a) On application, the Administration shall issue an identification card to any individual who:
 - (1) (I) Is a resident of this State[;] WHO:
 - [(2)] 1. Does not have a driver's license; AND
- [(3)] 2. Presents a birth certificate or other proof of age and identity acceptable to the Administration; [and] OR
 - (II) IS A NONRESIDENT WHO:
- 1. IS A STUDENT ENROLLED IN AN ACCREDITED SCHOOL, COLLEGE, OR UNIVERSITY OF THIS STATE; $\frac{AND}{A}$
- 2. PRESENTS A LICENSE TO DRIVE ISSUED TO THE INDIVIDUAL BY THE STATE OF WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL IS A RESIDENT; AND
- 3. <u>PRESENTS PROOF, ACCEPTABLE TO THE ADMINISTRATION</u>, THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS LIVING IN THIS STATE; AND
- [(4)] (2) Presents a completed application for an identification card on a form furnished by the Administration.
