SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 15A - Budget and Fiscal Planning

37.

- (a) As used in this subtitle:
  - (12) "SWORN OFFICER" MEANS:
- (I) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER CERTIFIED BY THE POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION; OR
- (II) A FULL-TIME PROBATIONARY EMPLOYEE OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT WHO:
- 1. <u>IS HIRED TO ATTEND A POLICE TRAINING ACADEMY TO BECOME A CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER; AND INC.</u>
- 2. <u>IS IN TRAINING OR IS FUNCTIONING AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER PENDING TRAINING.</u>
- (b) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975, and thereafter, the State shall pay to each subdivision, and to each qualifying municipality, each year in the manner and subject to the limitations and requirements hereinafter provided, an amount determined as follows:
- (8) MUNICIPAL SWORN OFFICER ALLOCATION. FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1991, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE STATE SHALL PAY TO BALTIMORE CITY AND EACH QUALIFYING MUNICIPALITY, IN ADDITION TO THE PAYMENTS MADE UNDER SUBPARAGRAPHS (1) THROUGH (7) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO \$1,000 \$900 FOR EACH SWORN POLICE OFFICER ACTUALLY EMPLOYED ON A FULL-TIME BASIS BY BALTIMORE CITY OR THE QUALIFYING MUNICIPALITY, AS DETERMINED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
