- (9) A STATEMENT FROM THE FAMILY DAY CARE PROVIDER ON HOW THE GRANT FUNDS WILL BE USED; AND
- (10) INFORMATION THAT RELATES TO THE FAMILY INCOME OF THE GRANT APPLICANT; AND

- (a) Except as provided in this subtitle, the Department may set the terms and conditions for GRANTS AND direct loans.
- (b) If the Department decides to lend money to an applicant, the Department shall prepare loan documents.
 - (c) The loan documents shall include:
 - (1) The rate of interest on the loan;
 - (2) The amount of the loan;
- (3) A requirement that before each disbursement of loan proceeds is released to the applicant, the applicant and the Department cosign the request for the funds:
 - (4) Provisions for repayment of the loan; and
 - (5) Any other provisions that the Department determines are necessary to
