AN ACT concerning

Water Quality Maryland Oil Disaster Containment, Clean Up and Contingency Fund and Maryland Underground Storage Tank Fund Maryland Underground Storage Tank Task Force

FOR the purpose of establishing a Maryland Underground Storage Tank Fund (UST Fund) in the Department of the Environment; requiring a person transferring gasoline and diesel fuel into the State to pay a certain fee per barrel of gasoline and diesel fuel transferred; requiring certain owners and operators of certain underground tanks to pay a certain tank fee on or before a certain date; providing for the deposit of certain fees into the UST Fund; establishing certain maximum and minimum balances in the Fund for making a certain determination on the collection of fees; providing for the relationship between the UST Fund and the existing Maryland Oil Disaster Containment, Clean Up and Contingency Fund; establishing certain purposes for the allocation of money in the UST Fund; requiring the owner or operator of certain underground tanks to take corrective action under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department to take certain corrective actions under certain circumstances; authorizing certain owners or operators to apply for reimbursement for certain costs or for a certain guarantee
