(Senate Bill 128)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Social Work Examiners

FOR the purpose of altering the standards of conduct upon which the State Board of Social Work Examiners may discipline an applicant or licensee.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 18–310(6)

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

18–310.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 18–311 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the applicant or licensee:

(6) Engages in a course of [unprofessional conduct, as defined by the rules and regulations of the Board] CONDUCT THAT IS INCONSISTENT WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN THE PRACTICE OF SOCIAL WORK;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
