

(b) If a person fails to comply with a subpoena issued under subsection (a) of this section, or fails to produce documents or other evidence, on petition of the [Department of Transportation] CERTIFICATION AGENCY, a court of competent jurisdiction may pass an order directing compliance with the subpoena or compelling the production of documents or other evidence.

(a) (1) Within 90 days after the end of the fiscal year, each designated unit shall report:

(i) to the Board;

(ii) to the {Governor's Office of Minority Affairs} ~~CERTIFICATION AGENCY~~; and

(iii) subject to § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the Legislative Policy Committee.

(2) A report under this subsection shall [state] for the preceding fiscal year:

(i) STATE the total number and value of procurement contracts between the designated unit and certified minority business enterprises; [and]

(ii) INDICATE the percentage that those procurement contracts represent of the total number and value of procurement contracts; AND

(III) CONTAIN OTHER SUCH INFORMATION AS REQUIRED BY THE ~~CERTIFICATION AGENCY~~ GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

(3) A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE IN A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE ~~CERTIFICATION AGENCY~~ GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

(b) Within 90 days after the end of the fiscal year, each unit that is not required to report under subsection (a) of this section shall send to the {Governor's Office of Minority Affairs} ~~CERTIFICATION AGENCY~~:

(1) to the extent available, the information required under subsection (a)(2) of this section; and

(2) a statement of the steps that the unit has taken to carry out the requirements of § 14-302(a) of this subtitle.

On or before December 31 of each year, the {Governor's Office of Minority Affairs} ~~CERTIFICATION AGENCY~~ shall submit to the Legislative Policy Committee a report summarizing the information that {Office} ~~AGENCY~~ receives under § 14-305(b) of this subtitle.
