(D) (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991, IN ADDITION TO THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL PAY THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS TO SELECTED COUNTIES:

<u>ALLEGANY</u>	\$ 500,000
<u>BALTIMORE CITY</u>	10,678,000
<u>GARRETT</u>	509,000
<u>SOMERSET</u>	767,000.

(2) THE AMOUNTS SHALL BE PAID TO THE SELECTED COUNTIES ONLY IF THE PROPERTY TAX RATE LEVIED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991 IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE PROPERTY TAX RATE LEVIED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990.

(3) THE AMOUNTS SHALL BE UTILIZED TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED IN THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR BY THE SELECTED COUNTIES FOR EDUCATION OR FOR LIMITING DRUG ABUSE.

(4) BY SEPTEMBER 1, 1990 EACH SELECTED COUNTY SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES WITH A REPORT AS TO THE USE OF THE FUNDS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990 ~~and shall be applicable to all fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 1990.~~ It shall remain effective for a period of one year and, at the end of June 30, 1991, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
