# AN ACT concerning

## Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages - Clarification of Time Hours of Sale

FOR the purpose of clarifying in the Dorchester County alcoholic beverage laws that "12 p.m." means 12 midnight; and clarifying language authorizing certain extended hours of sale under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the hours for sale of alcoholic beverages in Dorchester County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

97.

In Dorchester County, notwithstanding any other provisions of this subtitle, the hours for sale for alcoholic beverages [shall be] ARE as follows:

- (1) For the holders of a Class A (off-sale) beer license, sales are permitted Monday through Sunday from 6 a.m. to 12 [p.m.] MIDNIGHT, EXCEPT IF CHRISTMAS EVE OR NEW YEAR'S EVE IS ON A SUNDAY, FROM 6 A.M. ON SUNDAY TO 1 A.M. ON MONDAY.
  - (2) For the holders of a Class B (on-sale) beer license, sales are permitted:
- (i) Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m. on the following day; and
- (ii) Sunday from 1 p.m. to 12 [p.m.] MIDNIGHT, EXCEPT IF CHRISTMAS EVE OR NEW YEAR'S EVE IS ON A SUNDAY, FROM 1 P.M. TO 1 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.
- (3) For the holders of a Class B (on and off sale) beer and light wine license sales are permitted as follows:
