SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

1-603.

(b) In each of the districts provided for in § 1-602 of this subtitle, there shall be the following number of associate judges of the District Court:

- (1) District 1—23
- (2) District 2—4
- (3) District 3—6, two to be appointed from Cecil County
- (4) District 4—4, TWO TO BE APPOINTED FROM CHARLES COUNTY
- (5) District 5—11
- (6) District 6—11
- (7) District 7—7
- (8) District 8—12
- (9) District 9—3
- (10) District 10—6, two to be appointed from Carroll County and four to be appointed from Howard County
- (11) District 11—4, TWO TO BE APPOINTED FROM FREDERICK COUNTY AND TWO TO BE APPOINTED FROM WASHINGTON COUNTY
- (12) District 12—3, TWO TO BE APPOINTED FROM ALLEGANY COUNTY

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
