

(4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE BUDGET COMMITTEES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES AN ANNUAL REPORT BY JANUARY 15 OF EACH YEAR OF ACQUISITIONS MADE PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION.

(F) (1) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE ACQUISITION FUNDS TO STABILIZE THE STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY OF IMPROVEMENTS EXISTING ON LAND AT THE TIME OF ACQUISITION.

(2) THE COSTS TO STABILIZE THE STRUCTURAL INTEGRITY OF IMPROVEMENTS EXISTING ON LAND AT THE TIME OF ACQUISITION MAY NOT EXCEED 10 PERCENT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE LAND.

~~(F)~~ (G) (1) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1991 1990, ANY AMOUNT APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET, AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEAR, UP TO 25 PERCENT OF THE STATE'S SHARE OF FUNDS AVAILABLE UNDER THE PROGRAM MAY BE USED FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ON LAND OWNED BY THE STATE FOR THE USE OF THE DEPARTMENT IF THE IMPROVEMENTS ARE:

(I) APPROVED IN THE STATE BUDGET; AND

(II) COMPATIBLE WITH:

1. ANY MASTER PLAN DEVELOPED FOR THE LAND;

AND

2. THE NATURAL FEATURES OF THE LAND.

(2) IF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AMENDS THE BUDGET BILL TO STRIKE OUT AN IMPROVEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNOR, THE GOVERNOR MAY CONSIDER REALLOCATING THE FUNDS THROUGH A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR THE SAME FISCAL YEAR:

(I) TO FINANCE SPECIFIC ALTERNATIVE LAND ACQUISITION OR DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS; OR

(II) TO THE ADVANCE OPTION AND PURCHASE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 5-904(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

5-904.

(a) (1) Each year the Department, in consultation with the Office of Planning, shall prepare a list of recommended State projects for funding under this program for the next fiscal year.

(2) IN PREPARING THE LIST, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO PROPERTIES IN TARGETED AREAS.
