## WILLIAM DONALD SCHAEFER, Governor

- (2) The Governor shall appoint the Chairperson from the members of the Council.
- (3) The Governor may remove any member of the Council for any cause adversely affecting the member's ability or willingness to perform his or her duties.
  - (4) The term of a member is three years.
- (5) The terms of the members shall be staggered, so one-third of the Council will be appointed each year.
- (6) A member of the Council may be reappointed by the Governor at the end of a term.
- (7) In the event of a vacancy on the Council, the Governor shall appoint a successor.
- (8) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (9) A majority of the Council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business. The Council may adopt such other procedures necessary to ensure the orderly transaction of business.
- (10) The members of the Council may not receive compensation for their services. The members may be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, in accordance with the standard travel regulations as provided in the State budget.
- (11) The Chairperson may appoint subcommittees, as necessary, to study specific issues of the Council.
- (12) The Council may establish advisory committees to address specific pesticide related matters as may be needed to carry-out the intent of this Executive Order. These matters may include:
  - (a) Food safety;
  - (b) Pesticide application;
  - (c) Biotechnological uses;
  - (d) Impacts on groundwater;
  - (e) Integrated pest management;
  - (f) Homeowner use;
  - (g) Endangered and threatened species;
  - (h) Worker protection;
  - (i) Disposal; and
