SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-734.

- (a) A person may not sell, offer to buy or sell, or possess any of the following fish:
 - [(2) Butterfish less than 6 inches;]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 4-734(a)(3) through (13), respectively, of Article – Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 4-734(a)(2) through (12), respectively.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
