

(2) The tenure and manner of election of its officers.

(3) Staffing requirements and appointments.

(4) The bylaws and procedures used by the Commission for the regulation of its affairs and the conduct of its business.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any member of the St. Mary's County Building Authority Commission serving on July 1, 1990 shall continue to serve as a member of the Commission subject to the discretion of the County Commissioners, notwithstanding any prior limitation on the term of the member.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 55

(House Bill 868)

AN ACT concerning

Minimum Wage – Rates – Tip Credit

FOR the purpose of increasing the amount of tip credit an employer may take when calculating the minimum wage for employees on certain dates; authorizing certain employees subject to the Maryland Wage and Hour Law to pay a training wage to employees in certain circumstances; making a stylistic change; and making this Act an emergency measure.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
