

authorization to issue permits presently within the Natural Resources Article to Article 83B of the Annotated Code with modifications; granting the Director of the Maryland Historical Trust certain enforcement powers subject to certain notice and hearing requirements; making provisions of this Act severable; providing for the termination of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; specifying that the Trust shall provide for the orderly transition and transfer of certain personnel and facilities; requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development to implement certain Committee recommendations by a certain date; and generally relating to archaeological historic property, the establishment of an Archaeology Office and Advisory Committee on Archaeology within the Maryland Historical Trust and to the transfer of archaeological-related functions from the Department of Natural Resources to the Maryland Historical Trust.
