Control of storage, transport and disposal of Solid Waste, and control of storage of Petroleum Products and Hazardous Substances

FOR the purpose of modifying current standards for the storage and transport of solid waste, requiring certain solid waste transporters to secure permits, prohibiting illegal disposal of solid wastes, establishing rules for the handling of animal carcasses, recyclable materials, and the disposal of medical waste, requiring permits and bonds for solid waste processing operations, requiring a public hearing for solid waste processing sites and disposal operations, requiring technical plans and reports from processing operations, adding new provisions, establishing regulations designed to protect public health and safety and the environmental resources of the County by preventing the
