AN ACT concerning

Panhandles - Development and Zoning Regulations, Offenses

FOR the purpose of defining panhandle driveways and panhandle lots providing comprehensive regulations for panhandle lots in the development approval process, allowing an exception for panhandle lots in the zoning regulations and requiring real estate contracts and advertising to disclose that property is a panhandle lot.
