Chapter 1

Laws of Montgomery County, 1990

AN ACT to:

- (1) prohibit the Department of Environmental Protection from issuing a building permit to construct a private swimming pool until the owner complies with certain safety requirements;
 - (2) require certain swimming pools to be enclosed during construction;
- (3) delete natural planting from approved methods of enclosing a private swimming pool;
- (4) prohibit the owner from filling [[a]] <u>certain</u> private swimming pools until the pool has passed final inspection by the Department of Environmental Protection; and
 - (5) generally amend the law regulating swimming pools.
