Emergency Bill No. 18-89

Chapter 39

Laws of Montgomery County, 1989

AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

- (1) bring County floodplain regulations into conformance with State and federal requirements by establishing a floodplain district;
- (2) establish a regulatory process for building in and near floodplains;
- (3) define certain terms;
- (4) specify when a floodplain district permit is required;
- (5) establish permit application and plan review procedures;
- (6) establish inspection and enforcement procedures; and
- (7) generally authorize the Department of Environmental Protection to regulate construction and land development in floodplains.
