

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

- (3) remove supervisory authority for the purchasing office from the Director of Finance;
- (4) make certain technical and clarifying amendments;
- (5) provide that this Act may not be enforced until a certain date; and
- (6) generally provide for the creation and administration of the Office of Procurement.
