2. Article 40A of the Code, the Maryland Public Ethics Law;

3. § 7-210 of the Tax – Property Article regarding property tax exemptions for certain government-owned property; AND

4. ARTICLE 64A, §§ 12F THROUGH 12K, INCLUSIVE, OF THE CODE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the commissioners shall study whether the Injured Workers’ Insurance Fund should implement a system of competitive commissions. The commissioners shall submit their recommendations to the Legislative Policy Committee prior to January 1, 1992.

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CHAPTER 72

(Senate Bill 64)

AN ACT concerning

**Caroline County – State’s Attorney – Salary**
