~~(J) IN ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR OTHER ADJUDICATORY PROCEEDING A HEARING BOARD CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 3 MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION MAY HOLD HEARINGS AND RENDER DECISIONS WHICH SHALL CONSTITUTE THE DECISION OF THE ENTIRE COMMISSION.~~

(J) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COMMISSION ALONE SHALL HAVE FINAL NONDELEGABLE AUTHORITY TO ACT WITH RESPECT TO ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR OTHER ADJUDICATORY PROCEEDING.

(2) (I) THE COMMISSION MAY DELEGATE TO A COMMITTEE CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 3 MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION THE RESPONSIBILITY TO HOLD HEARINGS AND RENDER PRELIMINARY DECISIONS REGARDING DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS AND OTHER ADJUDICATORY PROCEEDINGS, INCLUDING EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS.

(II) A UNANIMOUS DECISION BY THE COMMITTEE IS BINDING AND SHALL CONSTITUTE A FINAL DECISION OF THE COMMISSION.

(3) (I) IF THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION IS NOT UNANIMOUS, THE COMMITTEE SHALL MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO THE FULL COMMISSION REGARDING THE COMMITTEE'S SUGGESTED DISPOSITION OF ANY DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR OTHER ADJUDICATORY PROCEEDING.

(4) (II) AFTER DETERMINING THAT THE COMMITTEE'S RECOMMENDATION IS COMPLETE, THE FULL COMMISSION SHALL RENDER A FINAL DECISION WHICH SHALL CONSTITUTE THE DECISION OF THE ENTIRE COMMISSION.

(5) A MAJORITY OF THE QUORUM AS ESTABLISHED UNDER § 4 OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL RENDER THE FINAL DECISION OF THE COMMISSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
